Methodology Notes:
Figures represent the proportion of first-time freshmen students from a common fall matriculation period who graduate within 4, 5, or 6 years, aggregated by ethnicity, with report filters for gender and full or part time status. Graduation rate calculations include degrees granted within the fall, spring, and trailing summer of the academic year (e.g. Fall 2017, Spring 2018, Summer 2018).
*SDSU calculates graduation rates by matching students in fall matriculation terms to degrees awarded using campus ID.

Full-time 5-Year

The CSU Chancellor's Office uses a slightly different ID matching methodology and also combines SDSU Main Campus cohorts with Imperial Valley cohorts. These methodology differences sometimes result in differences in cohort counts, continuation rates and graduation rates.
